#### FFA Participates in Area Land Contest

Sixteen members of the Diller-Odell FFA Chapter participated in the southeast area land-judging contest held on October 14<sup>th</sup> in Beatrice. The event was sponsored by the Nemaha Natural Resources District to provide experience in evaluating and learning how to treat and manage soil resources.

The contest had different areas of land to evaluate according to soil depth, texture, permeability, slope, organic material, and the amount of erosion. Land usage and treatment recommendation were made for each area. Ribbons were awarded to the top 45% of the contestants. There were 136 students from 10 schools making up 34 teams participating in the event. Individually, Katie Schultis placed first and Theresa Zarybnicky placed third. They both

earned a purple ribbon. Cody Scheele, Caleb

Schultis, Bladen Ahl, and Dylan Wolbert each received a blue ribbon. Jonathan Schmidt, Spencer Schmidt, and Ethan Rupprecht received red ribbons. Katie Zarybnicky, Cory Engelman, and Bailey Schroeder all received a white ribbon. The team of Katie Schultis, Cody Scheele,

Bladen Ahl, and Ethan Rupprecht received the second place plaque and qualified for state. The

team of Theresa Zarybnicky, Jonathan Schmidt, Katie Zarybnicky, and Bailey Schroeder placed third.

# SKIP Flu Clinic Sees Growth by Dusty Duis, School Nurse

On October 14, 2015, immunization nurses representing Public Health Solutions arrived to our school to host the annual SKIP Flu program. The goal of the program is to offer the vaccine to school students and staff so they do not need to miss school hours to obtain it. The vaccine is available to the insured and the uninsured. For those with insurance Public Health Solutions requests a copy of the insurance card and takes care of the billing; making it a very convenient and easy way for students to obtain the vaccine. This year the clinic saw a lot of activity compared to years past! Data available from 2009 shows that only 25.5% of the students took ad-

vantage of this opportunity. This year saw a 10.2% increase! 35.7% of students and 34 staff received their flu vaccine through this program. As your school nurse, it has always been my goal to see the participation numbers rise each year. With thanks for the school bulletin, school website, our local Griffin sportscasters, and The Village Voice I'm excited to report that since

2009 our participation rate has gone up every year! This is one convenient opportunity to take advantage of to help keep our children healthy! Thank you for your support and participation!




